### **Pork Market Trends:**

- Hog slaughter in the first three weeks of the year has averaged 6.3% above year ago levels while weights have added another 0.5% to the y/y increase in pork supplies.
- Ham prices remain significantly below year ago levels as packers have had to discount product enough to offset the tariff impact and maintain sales into the Mexican market.
- Late Easter may be negatively impacting the market in the near term as buyers have more time to accumulate product.
- Futures remain extremely volatile due to uncertainty regarding outlook for US pork export trade.
- Pork belly prices were lower for the week but still above year ago levels. End users will continue to build inventories for spring/summer needs, supporting belly prices in the next two months.
- Large slaughter has kept pork trim prices in check and loin prices remain very weak.

#### **Chicken Market Trends:**

- With no USDA reports, the latest information we have on egg sets and chick placements is more than a month old at this time.
- In December we noted a reduction in placements, resulting in lower slaughter in recent weeks. In the six weeks ending January 12 broiler slaughter has averaged 1.5% lower than a year ago.
- Reduction in chicken production has helped stabilize the market for chicken breast meat and leg quarters. Prices for chicken thigh meat is steady at this time but should be higher in the spring.
- Demand for chicken wings normally hits a seasonal high in February and early March as sports bars see a big increase in activity due to NFL playoffs and college basketball torunaments. Wing prices are up 30 cents (+20%) in the last four weeks.

### **Beef Market Trends:**

- Cattle prices have trended higher and futures expect prices to be higher still in February as poor weather conditions negatively affect feedlots and cattle performance.
- Packers have been forced to pay up for cattle and packer margins have declined but remain positive.
- The wholesale beef price index (cutout) is higher than a year ago despite the increase in beef production due to strong demand for steak cuts as well as export items like briskets and chuck rolls.
- Ground beef prices have not been as strong as earlier expected, in part because of competition from other less expensive proteins, such as pork chops and boneless chicken breast
- Similarly, the price of round cuts has been lower than a year ago due to more competition in the retail meat case.

#### **Turkey Market Trends**

- Producers have consistently cut back placements in recent months and this is reflected in lower slaughter. In the six weeks ending January 12 turkey slaughter has averaged 3% lower than a year ago.
- While slaughter is down, producers have sought to make up pounds by raising birds to heavier weights. Average live turkey weight is currently 32 pounds/bird (14.5kg live), 2.8% higher than a year ago.
- Turkey production is just 0.4% lower than a year ago. As a result, prices for turkey breast have changed little in the last three months. Lower ham and beef round prices have also affected demand for turkey in the deli counter.
- Thigh meat prices have declined in recent weeks but remain as much as 9% higher than a year ago. Low prices for pork and chicken trim have pressured MST prices lower, now down 29% compared to a year ago levels.

















### Barrow/Gilt Dressed Carcass Weights, 5-day Moving Avg. - All hogs




### Weekly Average FI Cattle Carcass Weights (Includes Fed & Non Fed Cattle)














Primal Rib Cutout Value, USDA, Daily, \$/cwt

# RATIO OF CHICK PLACEMENTS VS. EGG SETS (21 DAY LAG)
















