Pork Market Trends:

- Hog slaughter has exceeded 2.5 million head per week in four of the last six weeks. Pork supplies are plentiful and higher than earlier expected. This continues to pressure US pork prices lower.
- Ham prices are especially weak. More bone-in hams are trading in the spot market as a result of the larger than expected slaughter, inadequate labor to de-bone hams, and ongoing tariffs on US hams in Mexico. Ham prices are 22% lower than a year ago. In 2015, a year which also saw a glut of hams in the spot market prices were as low as 40 cents by late March.
- Belly prices are drifting lower as packers steadily lower prices in order to encourage processors to put more bellies in cold storage. Seasonally belly prices remain weak into April but then are sharply higher in May/Jun/Jul.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Broiler slaughter has been lower than a year ago in the last two weeks and based on USDA hatchery information we should see only minimal increase in broiler production in Feb/Mar.
- USDA has once again started reporting on the number of broiler eggs set in incubators and chicks placed in grow out houses. While the number of eggs set in incubators during the last six weeks is up 1.4%, chick placements are up only 0.2%, which should keep slaughter near year ago levels.
- Lower slaughter has helped stabilize the chicken product market. According to USDA breast meat prices were 2% higher than the previous week and 10.5% higher than four weeks ago.

Beef Market Trends:

- Extreme variation in temperatures continues to take a toll on feedlots. In some areas there have been 70 degree swings in temperatures in a matter of days. Cattle weight gains have been negatively affected, in turn reducing the supply of beef coming to market.
- February is a slow month for retail beef sales and this is reflected in the weak trend for ground beef and especially the price of 50CL beef trim. Steak cuts continue to benefit from robust demand at foodservice, however.
- The price of rounds and chucks continues to hold near year ago levels. Despite extremely low prices for pork and chicken retailers like to merchandise beef cuts due to strong consumer demand and higher revenue potential.
- US beef exports in November were 2% higher than a year ago, thanks largely to strong demand from Asian markets.

Turkey Market Trends

- Turkey slaughter has been sharply lower in recent weeks, which should limit supply availability and support higher prices into the spring.
- Slaughter in the first five weeks of the year has been 8% lower than the previous year. Weather may have played a role in the shortfall in slaughter, especially the last two weeks, but overall turkey chick placement data suggests supplies will be lower in Q1 and Q2 of 2019.
- Seasonally turkey breast prices are steady in Q1 but then start to move higher in April and May. Low prices for competing products, especially hams, should help keep turkey breast meat prices in check in the near term.
- Turkey exports in November (latest available data) were 2.3% higher than the previous year. Exports to Mexico, the top market for US turkey, were down 3% while exports to Hong Kong jumped 47% vs. year ago levels.

CONTRIBUTION TO YEAR/YEAR CHANGE IN MEXICO BEEF PRODUCTION


