Pork Market Trends:

- We have raised our forecasts substantially, largely due to the forward risk from big Chinese purchase orders. Already China purchases have increased prices in Canada and EU and there is significant upside risk going forward.
- Pork prices may not push higher immediately but retail demand generally improves in May while hog slaughter is expected to decline from around 2.5 million head per week not to under 2.3 million head in late May/early June
- Reports from China indicate the breeding herd in some regions may be down as much as 40%. This implies an unimaginable supply hole in that market. China currently has half the world's pig population and relies on domestic pigs for 96% of its pork consumption.

Chicken Market Trends:

- The spread of African Swine Fever in China is expected to result in a significant shortfall in meat protein supplies. Beef prices are extremely high in China and consumers are expected to buy more chicken.
- US chicken exports in January were almost 5% higher than a year ago but the price of product exported was 7% lower than last year.
- Improving export demand and tight freezer inventories has resulted in a notable improvement in chicken leg quarter and thigh meat prices. The price of leg quarters, a key export item, is up 40% compared to mid February levels.
- Chicken breast meat prices seasonally increase in the spring and summer on improving grilling demand. Prices are currently up 15% compared to February levels. Higher pork prices and limited supply growth should help bolster prices in April and May.

Beef Market Trends:

- Cattle market is looking for direction at this time while beef prices have taken a small step back, in line with normal seasonal trends during this time of year.
- Beef demand improves in late April and May due to improving weather and a number of celebrations that bolster traffic at restaurants and grocery stores. Mother's Day weekend is May 12, Memorial Day weekend is May 27 and Father's Day weekend is June 16.
- 50CL beef prices have been steady in the last two weeks but should be notably higher in late April/May on aggressive ground beef features. Cattle weights are down 1.5% y/y.
- Exports to Japan have slowed down but that could change should Australia slaughter decline in the second half of the year. Exports to Hong Kong remain weak as tighter border controls have limited the "gray trade" with Mainland China.

Turkey Market Trends

- Whole turkey demand remains weak and this could lead producers to further reduce future output potential to bring supplies more in line with demand.
- Inventory of all turkey products in cold storage at the end of February was 452.2 million pounds, 5.8% higher than a year ago and 27% higher than the five year average.
- Breast meat inventory was also up 6% vs. last year and 54% higher than the five year average.
- Breast meat prices are higher than a year ago but have been fairly stable in the last three months as supplies remain adequate.
- Turkey poult placements during Dec/Jan/Feb were down an average 5% vs. last year, which should limit supplies in late spring and early summer. Turkey breast prices should be higher in the second half of the year from current levels.













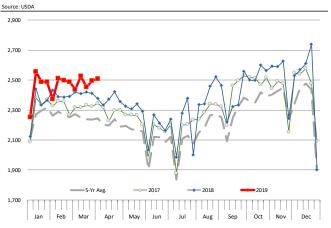

WEEKLY STEER AND HEIFER SLAUGHTER. '000 HEAD



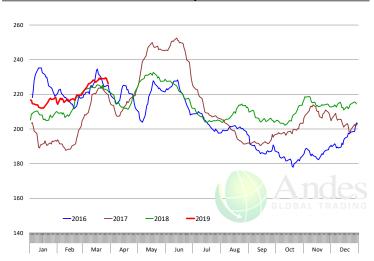

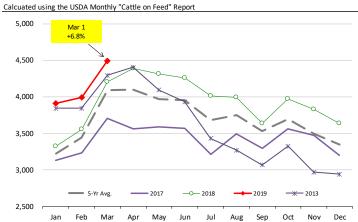


PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS

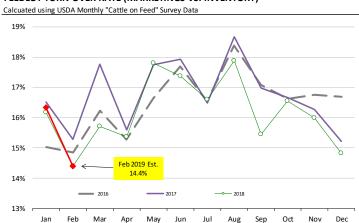




INVENTORY OF CATTLE THAT HAVE BEEN ON FEED FOR 120 DAYS OR MORE

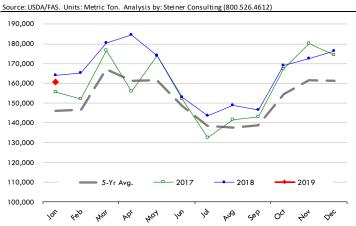

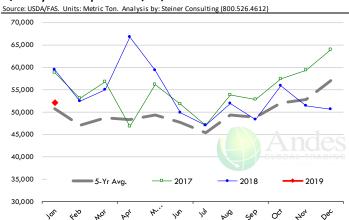

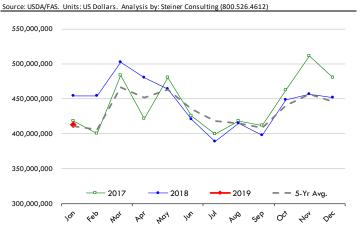

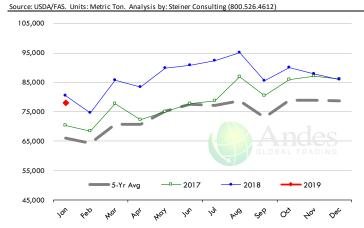
Y/Y Ch. in Jan. 19 vs. Jan 18 US Beef and Veal Export Volume



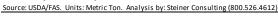

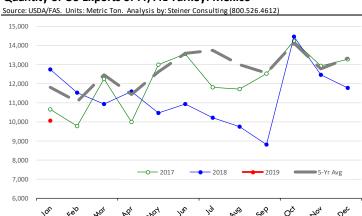
Y/Y Ch. in Jan. 19 vs. Jan 18 US Turkey Export Value (\$)



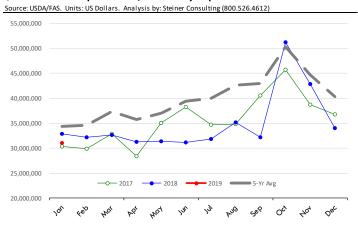

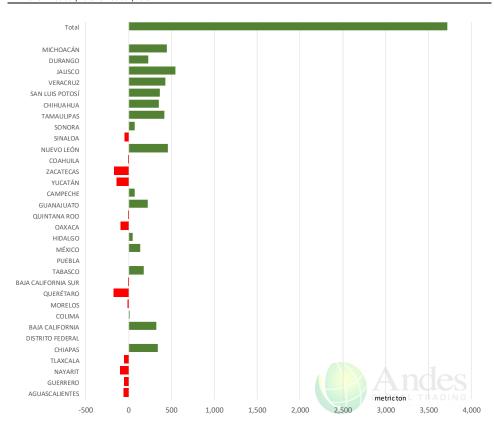




Mexico Beef Production
