## Pork Market Trends:

- Pork supplies have recovered much faster than most expected. Higher slaughter and heavier carcass hogs caused production last week to jump 8% vs. year ago levels and 68% from where it was on May 2.
- The increase in production comes at a time when retail pork prices remain extremely high, reflecting the purchase prices in late May. In the near term this has slowed down the flow of product through the supply chain, pressuring prices lower.
- Packers have implemented new procedures that have negatively affected yields. This has resulted in more untrimmed product to be sold in the open market at significantly depressed prices. Boneless ham muscles are now trading almost 5 times the price of bone-in, skin on hams. Belly prices remain weak while loin values have crashed from the peak prior to Memorial Day.

#### **Chicken Market Trends:**

- Broiler supplies are expected to remain under year ago levels through the end of June, a function of the decline in chick placements during May.
- The trend in broiler supplies has started to shift, however, as plant capacity constraints have improved. Egg sets for the last reported week were up 2.4% from a year ago while chick placements were just under last year's levels.
- Producers have also offset some of the decline in slaughter by bringing heavier weight birds to market. Slaughter of birds over 7.8 pounds is now running 9% above year ago levels.
- The increase in overall production, especially production of heavy birds, has pressured breast meat prices lower. Jumbo boneless/skinless breasts are now as much as 34% compared to mid May. Dark meat prices are down as well while MSC prices a trading sideways.

### **Beef Market Trends:**

- Beef production has posted year on year increases for two consecutive weeks. In early May fed cattle slaughter was down by 40% compared to a year ago.
- Retail beef prices in early June were up as much as 35% from a year ago and retailers have cut beef features by 60% or more. Higher prices, lack of features and quick ramp up in production have caused wholesale prices to hit a wall.
- The biggest price declines have come in products that saw big price appreciation in May, round and chuck cuts and ground beef.
- Current prices appear to be attracting retailer interest and forward sales for delivery in late July and August are about 20% higher than a year ago. We think those items have found a bottom.
- Steak cuts could see further downward pressure in July.

#### **Turkey Market Trends**

- Turkey slaughter in the last few weeks has been 3-5% below year ago levels and that trend is expected to continue going forward.
- Turkey poult placements in May were down 11% from a year ago. This was the lowest placement figure in at least 25 years.
- The reduction in placements was a response to the uncertainty about demand at large sandwich chains. However, foodservice demand is slowly improving and combined with the reduction in supply it has started to push breast meat prices higher.
- Turkey thigh meat prices likely found a bottom in April and have been trending up as well. They remain under year ago levels, however.
- Whole turkey supplies remain tight. Prices should continue to trend higher into Q3.













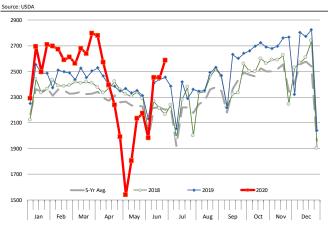

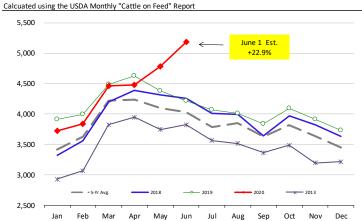
#### **PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS**



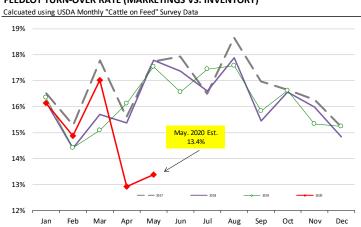
#### CATTLE MARKETINGS, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS

### FEEDLOT TURN-OVER RATE (MARKETINGS VS. INVENTORY)

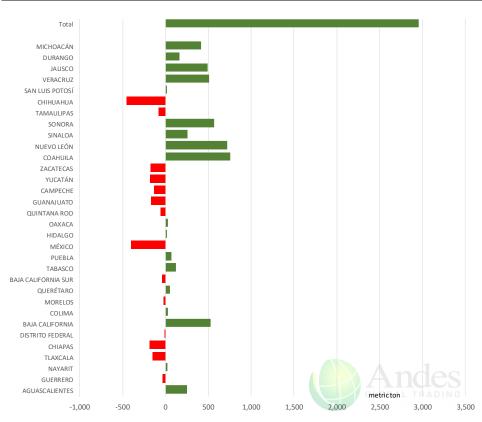
