Pork Market Trends:

- Pork supplies should be plentiful through the fall, helping keep hog/pork prices in check. Latest USDA inventory survey showed that hogs scheduled to come to market in June-Aug period were 12% or 3.3 million head higher than a year ago.

- Hog supplies for the fall are also expected to be about 2% higher than the record levels of a year ago.

- Export demand remains a major wild card and source of uncertainty for futures. China accounted for 40% of all US pork exports in May. US-China relations have quickly deteriorated in recent weeks, leading to speculation that China will scale back its purchases of US pork and other agricultural goods.

- Loin prices will come under pressure now that holiday grilling demand is behind us. Pork trim is plentiful given record slaughter for this time of year. Boneless hams continue to command big premiums vs. bone-in product.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Broiler production was about 3% lower than a year ago in the last two weeks of June but overall the broiler market remains well supplied, reflected in weak pricing across most products.

- Thigh meat prices that normally hold well through July have been trending lower, facing increasing competition from other proteins at retail.

- Boneless/skinless chicken breasts are widely available and pricing is often below quoted market. Some fast food operators were gearing up for strong sales as states started t reopen. Repipelining offered a brief boost to sales. Now that a second wave is affecting Southern and Western states, expectations are for prices to once again trend lower.

- Chicken exports were down 4% in May. Higher exports to China helped offset double digit declines to other key markets, including Mexico.

Beef Market Trends:

- This was a holiday shortened slaughter week but overall beef production has recovered and due to heavier carcass weights it is running above year ago levels.

- Increase in slaughter and higher fed cattle weights (+4.5%) has resulted in more fat beef trim available in the market. Prices for 50CL beef dropped under 50 cents per pound vs. near \$3 per pound just a few weeks ago.

- Drought in parts of Texas, Oklahoma and Kansas as well as the increase in slaughter capacity has resulted in more beef cows going to market. Beef cow slaughter fort the latest reported week was up 13% from a year ago.

- Higher beef cow slaughter and more imports have started to pressure lean beef values. Prices for steak cuts are heaving lower, in part due to weaker seasonal demand but also because of continued weakness at foodservice.

Turkey Market Trends

- Weekly turkey production in June averaged 6% below year ago levels. In addition to bringing fewer birds to market, producers have also shifted to producing more hens, which tends to reduce the average weight of birds and ultimately production.

- Limited supplies and a strong US dollar negatively impacted turkey exports in May. Exports to all markets were down 32% from a year ago and exports to Mexico, the top US market for turkey meat, were down 36%.

- Reduction in poult placements will keep turkey supplies under year ago levels for the remainder of the year. Weaker foodservice demand continues to keep turkey breast prices in check. Whole turkey prices are firm and should trend higher in Q3. Supply of all turkeys in cold storage at the end of May was down 15% from a year ago.




















Ham, Inner Shank, FOB Plant, USDA










Quantity of US Exports of Fr/Frz/Cooked Pork: Mexico








Y/Y Ch. in May. 20 vs. May 19 US Beef and Veal Export Volume





Quantity of US Exports of Fr/Frz Chicken: World Total






Y/Y Ch. in May. 20 vs. May 19 US Turkey Export Value (\$)









June 1 Inventory of Hogs Kept for Breeding. 1978 - 2020. Source: USDA-NASS


