#### Pork Market Trends:

- While hog slaughter has increased, up 10% last week, the supply of hogs in farms continues to far outpace the ability of packing plants to process them in a timely fashion.

- Pork market in the US remain well supplied and output will remain high through the end of the year.

- Latest USDA export report showed very strong sales to Asia and Mexico and this helped bolster hog futures in the near term.

- Sales to Mexico in the last report were over 10,000 MT, about 30% higher than the current pace of shipments. This is helping support the ham market. Ham and belly prices to Asian destinations have also increased substantially.

- Pork belly prices are range bound in the near term. While seasonally this is a time for bellies to gain, ample pork supplies and uncertain foodservice demand has put a damper on pork belly prices for now.

#### Chicken Market Trends:

- Broiler supplies are lower than a year ago and still pricing in the complex remains weak. Whole birds are under significant pressure as lack of labor is putting more whole birds in the market.

- Current decline in slaughter also reflects the reduction in chick placements a few weeks ago. Placements were higher in late June and July and currently are near last year's levels, which should result in modest slaughter gains in the next few weeks.

- The market for thigh meat has come under significant pressure due to the seasonal decline in domestic demand, weaker export demand and increased competition at retail.

Wing prices have gained recently as reopening in some regions and return of sports is expected to bolster demand.
MSC prices are steady but should come under pressure in the fall on weaker seasonal demand.

### Beef Market Trends:

- Despite money flow, the fundamentals in the beef/cattle market remain uncertain. Some states where COVID-19 cases have spiked are rolling back the reopening of restaurants and bars.

- Supply of cattle on feed as of July 1 is expected to be near year ago levels. However, the supply of cattle that have been on feed for more than 150 days is expected to be up 42% from a year ago. In the near term feedlot bargaining power is limited.

- Fat trim prices are extremely weak as slaughter is near year ago levels and the cattle coming to market have more fat than usual for this time of year.

- Lean beef prices are steady while high value steak cuts are drifting lower due to weaker demand.

#### **Turkey Market Trends**

- Whole bird market continues to trade very firm. Supplies are limited and sellers have limited availability. Reduction in poult placements through the first half of the year continues to keep a lid on supplies.

- Export demand from China and Hong Kong is reportedly quite strong and this has helped demand for some parts. However, demand from Mexico remains lackluster.

Breast meat market remains well supplied and prices continue to trade sideways. Retail deli business is good but not great. Some fast food operators have seen a strong recovery but others continue to struggle. This has left the breast meat market without any clear direction at this time.
 Labor remains a challenge for processors, resulting in tight

supplies of items such as thigh meat and MST.






#### Primal Chuck Cutout Value, USDA, Daily, \$/cwt



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


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### **Mexico Beef Production**

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

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
