Pork Market Trends:

- Cooler temperatures and a pullback in ham prices cut short the rally in cash hog prices. Futures were also lower on concerns that ample pork supplies will continue to pressure prices lower in the fall.

- Export data was encouraging, showing robust sales to China and Mexico.

- Pork belly prices normally are higher in July and August on a combination of tight supplies, foodservice demand and higher retail features. Belly prices are flat, however, as production is running 10% above last year and foodservice demand continues to struggle.

- Pork trim prices remain firm but should be seasonally weaker in September and October.

Chicken Market Trends:

- The broiler industry is currently at a crossroads. On the one hand, low feed costs and increase in slaughter capacity once again offer opportunities to increase volume/sales. However, weak foodservice demand and strong competition in retail have put significant downward pressure on some items.

- Whole bird market remains over supplied. Additionally, as more labor starts to return to fabrication lines packers are able to process leg quarters into drums, thighs and boneless product. Prices for dark meat items have come under significant pressure as supply has recovered.

- Hatching flock on July 1 was up 3.4% from a year ago. However, producers have limited egg sets and chick placements in the last two weeks in an effort to keep supply in check once Labor Day demand comes to an end.

Beef Market Trends:

- Cattle prices/futures were higher last week on reports of better than expected exports and strong forward sales for Labor Day and post Labor Day features.

- The recent pullback in brisket prices and the weaker USD has created excellent export opportunities.

- Wholesale beef prices have stabilized and are expected to gain in the near term thanks to the seasonal boost from Labor Day demand. The price of 50CL beef trim has increased by 25% in the last two weeks thanks to a rebound in ground beef demand and sales.

- Despite the recent rally, there is still significant uncertainty about beef prices this fall. The increase in COVID cases will continue to limit foodservice demand. Without more stimulus, the US economy could see an uptick in unemployment, which is usually bearish for beef demand.

Turkey Market Trends

- Turkey prices for the most part have been trending sideways. Supplies in the spot market reported as adequate and buyers feel no pressure to try secure product past the next two weeks. It is a wait and see market.

- Breast meat supplies are available and prices have been stuck in a tight range for the last few weeks. Slaughter in Q2 and Q3 has been down for the last three years and it is expected to be down again this year. Still, turkey breast prices in July were lower than they were three years ago.

- Foodservice demand remains a major source of uncertainty for turkey producers, especially those focusing on producing processing birds. Retail product is holding together much better. Supply of whole birds in cold storage at the end of June was 11% lower than a year ago and the five year average. However, supplies of frozen turkey parts are burdensome and pricing remains soft.
















NE BONELESS BREAST BROILER WHITE TRIM MEAT, UNDER 15%, FRESH








PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS



INVENTORY OF CATTLE THAT HAVE BEEN ON FEED FOR 120 DAYS OR MORE




CATTLE MARKETINGS, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS








Mexico Beef Production




