## **Pork Market Trends:**

- Hog slaughter reached 2.664 million head last week, the highest since early spring. Packers tried to run as hard as they could given that slaughter in the next two weeks will be limited due to the Labor Day holiday weekend.
- Good export demand has supported ham prices but the big increase in slaughter has helped keep prices in check. Export sales to Mexico last week were once again over 10,000 MT and USDA is also reporting strong sales to Asian markets.
- Labor shortages remain a major concern for packers. Less trim is available, keeping 72CL prices high. Boneless ham prices remain abnormally high relative to bone-in hams.

#### **Chicken Market Trends:**

- Broiler production last week was higher, largely due to heavier birds coming to market. The price of boneless/skinless breasts has shown some improvement and it did not take long for producers to respond.
- The price of boneless skinless breast is in a transition period with a tendency to lower prices. We think in part this reflects the shift towards other proteins at retail. The consumer has a lot of options and in the last few weeks chicken dark meat has struggled to gain traction.
- Whole bird prices remain extremely weak, in part because producers cannot process the entire supply available.
- Not all chicken prices are low, however. The price of wings remains extremely high. Wing inventories at the end of July were 22% lower than a year ago and 31% lower than the five year average. Prices for chicken tenders are also firm as some end users have shifted to that product in order to avoid the quality issues associated with jumbo breasts.

## Beef Market Trends:

- Wholesale beef prices have been trending higher in the last three weeks as packers sold significant quantities to retailers for Labor Day features and supplies in the spot market are limited.
- Steak cuts have registered some of the biggest gains, a surprise given continued weak demand by sit down restaurants and high rates of unemployment. We think part of the reason is due to the fact that consumers have shifted some of the dollars they used to spend on dining out towards upgrading some of the protein they consumer at home.
- Fat beef trim prices are now extremely weak. Heavy carcass weights and recovery in beef production has pushed more trim in the market. Seasonally ground beef demand slows down in September and the government is buying fewer hamburger patties for its school lunch programs.

#### **Turkey Market Trends**

- The inventory of whole frozen turkeys at the end of July was 8% lower than a year ago. Whole turkey prices remain firm but we expect the pace of price inflation to slow down as freezer inventories slowly recover.
- Breast meat prices remain stable even as the total supply of turkey meat coming to market is often lower than a year ago. Demand at sandwich chain restaurants remains weak, in part because many people continue to work from home. Turkey breast sandwiches were a key staple for these restaurants and the demand environment, especially for lunch business, has changed dramatically.
- Turkey thigh meat prices remain below year ago levels but availability varies greatly between suppliers. Supplies in part of the country remain tight as Mexico demand has improved and some plants are still struggling with high rates of COVID infections.
















#### **PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS**




#### **CATTLE MARKETINGS**, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS

#### FEEDLOT TURN-OVER RATE (MARKETINGS VS. INVENTORY)










