Pork Market Trends:

- Poor weather conditions in lowa caused some slaughter disruptions last week and yet overall slaughter was still over 2.6 million head. Hogs continue to come to market on the heavy side, which has bolstered pork supplies. Production last week was 1% higher than last year but 15% higher than two years ago.
- Good domestic demand and strong exports continue to underpin wholesale pork prices. The pork cutout is currently 13% higher than a year ago and 22% higher than two years ago, despite more pork coming to market each day.
- Ham primal value last week was 47% higher than it was in 2019. Mexico remains a big buyer, with USDA reporting shipments for the most current week over 18,000 MT.
- Pork inventory in cold storage as of January 1 was 30% smaller than a year ago and the inventory of hams was down 37%, both supportive of pork prices in the near term.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Chicken prices have started to trend higher, in part because of slowly improving demand but also because producers have been disciplined and continue to keep supplies in check.
- Broiler production was down in the last quarter of 2020 and that trend continues, with slaughter running 1-2% below year ago.
- Wing prices are extremely firm on Super bowl demand and extremely tight freezer stocks. As of January 1, the supply of wings in the freezer was 43% lower than normal.
- Breast meat prices have gained about 30% in the last few weeks. A number of fast food chains are rolling out chicken sandwich promotions and combined with limited slaughter this has helped bolster prices in the near term.
- Prices of leg quarters are trending higher due to stronger export demand while the prices for boneless skinless dark meat are increasing due to a strengthening of the domestic demand.

Beef Market Trends:

- Fed cattle slaughter is currently running about 2% above last year and combined with heavier cattle coming to market, beef production is up over 4% vs. last year.
- As with pork, wholesale beef prices are firm in large part because of the shift in inflation expectations. Buyers are concerned about beef supplies in Q2 given the decline in fed cattle placements in the fall. While feedlot inventory is about the same as last year, supplies are front loaded, with more cattle expect to be marketed in January and February and less availability in late March, April and early May.
- Cattle futures took a step back on profit taking but cattle prices for Q2 are higher than Q1, which is unusual. Beef exports were very strong last week, with all major markets ramping up purchases. On the other hand imports are running as much as 12% below last year. Lean beef prices should be higher into March and early April.

Turkey Market Trends:

- Little has changed in the turkey complex since last fall. Supplies are tight, which continues to keep whole bird market fully priced. Retailers are working to cover holiday needs at this time with prices expected to steadily increase in Q2 and Q3.
- Feed costs are up between 35% and 50% and this will continue to negatively impact producer margins. While higher prices for whole birds are positive, they represent a relatively small share of overall turkey production. The more critical part of the industry is the market for turkey breast and prices there remain stagnant. As a result, we expect to see lower turkey slaughter in Q1 and Q2 as producers look to bring a margin back in the business.
- Export demand is reportedly strong and this has contributed to an upward trend for drums, wings and necks, Prices for these items are up as much as 10% compared to the start of the year and approaching 2020 levels.






Barrow/Gilt Dressed Carcass Weights, 5-day Moving Avg. - All hogs












Primal Loin Cutout Value, USDA, Daily, \$/cwt


PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS




CATTLE MARKETINGS, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS

FEEDLOT TURN-OVER RATE (MARKETINGS VS. INVENTORY)




