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Pork Market Trends:

- Pork production has been disrupted in the last few weeks by snow and extreme cold weather. While producers were able to make up some of the lost production over the weekend, during the week end users faced tighter supply availability in the spot market and higher prices.
- Pork exports in December were 6% lower than the previous year but still some 21% higher than two years ago. Exports in January have been robust as strong sales/ shipments to Mexico have offset some of the slowdown in exports to China.
- Ham prices remain firm as processors came into the new year with limited freezer inventories. Easter is earlier this year, leaving buyers with a limited window to produce and deliver ham to customers.
- Pork belly prices are up as users look to bolster inventories ahead of expected higher prices in Q2 and Q3.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Broiler slaughter continues to run below year ago levels and this is expected to continue through at least March. Egg sets and chick placements are still running about 1.5% below year ago levels even as the layer flock is 3.8% above last year.
- Producers are in a holding pattern, they are managing the supply in the near term so it matches available demand but they are also standing ready to ramp up production when/if foodservice demand recovers.
- Prices for MSC have been trending higher as processors continue to struggle with labor and are not running full processing lines. Higher prices for bone meal also mean that processors do not have to maximize the amount of MSC they produce.
- Wing prices remain extremely higher but should be lower in April and May as demand seasonally subsides. Leg quarter prices are expected to trend higher.

Beef Market Trends:

- Cattle slaughter was lower last week as extreme cold temperatures made it difficult to move livestock. The decline in slaughter helped keep beef prices at elevated levels.
- Wholesale beef values should seasonally slow down in February and early March, in part due to Lent. However, retailers have booked significant volumes for Easter and post-Easter features. Easter is early this year, which should result in an earlier boost to wholesale beef prices.
- Our estimate is for beef production in Q2 to be down 3.7% compared to 2019 levels (2020 is difficult to compare to) and per capita availability is expected to be 5% below 2019. Wholesale beef prices are expected to be higher due to less supply available and easing pressures from the pandemic.

Turkey Market Trends

- Little has changed in the turkey complex and pricing trend varies greatly on the product. Whole bird prices remain firm due to lower inventories at the start of the year and expectations for continued y/y declines in slaughter, at least through June.
- Breast meat market remains at a standstill and spot supplies are adequate despite the lower slaughter. Fast food demand has yet to recover as deli shops in general do not have a drive-thru. Lunch business that used to be a driver for turkey breast sandwiches also remains weak with more people working from home.
- Turkey exports in December were down 5% and exports to Mexico were down 8%. Dark meat supplies remain limited and prices for drums and thigh meat have quickly escalated, in part because of improving export demand but also higher prices for competing products.




Quantity of US Exports of Fr/Frz/Cooked Pork: World Total






Y/Y Ch. in Dec. 20 vs. Dec 19 US Beef and Veal Export Volume












Y/Y Ch. in Dec. 20 vs. Dec 19 US Turkey Export Value (\$)










