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Pork Market Trends:

OBAL TRADINO

- Sharply higher prices for processing items, bellies, hams and trim, continue to support overall wholesale pork prices. Lower than expected slaughter in the last two weeks, continued good export demand, lower freezer stocks and preparation for better Q2 demand have all contributed to the current increase in prices.

- US wholesale pork prices are up 22% since early February. During this period wholesale belly prices have increased 38%. Normally wholesale pork belly prices are weaker in February and March due to limited foodservice demand. However, sharply higher summer hog futures have encouraged processors to accelerate production as they anticipate even higher prices down the road. Current market is extremely risky. In 2019 a similar early spike in prices was followed by a sharp decline and then another round of higher prices in July and early August.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Broiler slaughter has been moderately above year ago levels in the last two weeks but the increase is still far from offsetting the February shortfall in slaughter.

- The market for mechanically separated chicken is red hot and prices have escalated quickly given very tight spot supplies and inelastic short term demand. Higher prices for other proteins, especially pork, and supply reductions have caused prices to spike to the highest levels in years.

- Dark meat prices have been trending higher and this is expected to continue in April and May as demand continues to seasonally improve.

- Prices for boneless/skinless chicken breasts are steady in the near term. While seasonally prices tend to gain in Q2, we think breast meat price inflation will lag price inflation for other items. Wing prices should ease lower in April and May.

Beef Market Trends:

- Cattle slaughter has recovered following weather disruptions in mid February. Cow/bull slaughter is up almost 30k head in the last three weeks, offsetting the 27k head reduction in slaughter during the week ending 2/20.

- The increase in cow slaughter has helped limit price inflation for lean grinding beef but prices remain well above year ago levels. We expect lean beef prices to be higher in April and May, in part because of higher retail features and improving foodservice demand but also the seasonal decline in cow slaughter.

- Prices for round cuts are heading lower, in line with seasonal trends for this time of year. Steak cut prices have also pulled back, which we see as a buying opportunity. We still expect higher prices in late April and May.

- We think on feed inventory on March 1 was +1.5% y/y.

Turkey Market Trends

Turkey supply remains limited and we expect that situation to persist at least through Q2. Limited supply has negatively impacted exports, with January shipments down 7.2% from a year ago. Exports to Mexico in January were about unchanged but exports to Asian markets were down sharply.
Demand for whole turkeys remains good as retailers and distributors look to shore up inventories.

- The market for turkey breast remains steady given soft food service demand in the near term. However, limited supply growth and expected recovery in demand is expected to result in higher turkey breast prices in late spring and summer. Frozen breast prices are trending higher for that reason.

- MST prices have jumped sharply higher, following the up trend for other processing items. Supply is tight. Drum prices trading sideways in the last few days.









Primal Rib Cutout Value, USDA, Daily, \$/cwt






Quantity of US Exports of Fr/Frz Chicken: World Total






Y/Y Ch. in Jan. 21 vs. Jan 20 US Broiler Export Value (\$)






Quantity of US Exports of Fr/Frz Chicken: Mexico










Mexico Beef Production


