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Pork Market Trends:

- Pork supplies remain extremely tight, especially for processing items. The price of 42CL pork (fat trim) is now more than 200% higher than a year ago and at new record levels.
- Lower than expected slaughter, pent up demand, limited freezer inventories and robust exports have all contributed to current pork price inflation.
- The supply situation will likely remain difficult in the near term. The most recent USDA inventory survey indicated that market hog supply was 1.4 million head smaller than expected. The number of baby pigs born (pig crop) in the Dec-Feb quarter was 1.4% lower than the previous year. This will limit pork supplies through the summer.
- The breeding herd is now at the lowest point in three yeas, limiting production potential for later this fall. Export demand remains key for pork prices in second half of 2021.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Broiler market tone reported as firm, with prices for the most part steady this week.
- Foodservice continues to slowly recover and distributors remain active, looking to fill needs for the spring. Spot supply for processing items, especially MSC, reportedly very tight and offers remain firm.
- Wing prices also continue to hold a firm undertone as spot supply remains very thin.
- Monthly poultry slaughter data for February released today showed broiler slaughter down 5.6% from a year ago. Weights were up a little bit under 1%, putting broiler production 4.8% below last year's levels.
- Broiler producers continue to keep egg sets and chick placements in check. For the week ending March 20, egg sets were 1% lower than a year ago while chick placements were down 1.8%.

Beef Market Trends:

- The inventory of cattle on feed as of March 1 was 1.6% higher than a year ago. More importantly, the supply of market ready cattle is currently almost 8% higher than a year ago. In the near term fed cattle supplies are adequate, with packer capacity a key limiting factor.
- Seasonally fed cattle weights decline in April and May. As packers ramp up slaughter to support grilling demand, we expect feedlots to slowly become more current. This suggests more limited cattle availability in the second half of the year, and higher cattle prices.
- The price of beef fat trim has been very weak in the last three months but that will change in April and May. Very high pork trim prices will shift some demand towards beef trim. Prices for steak cuts should also increase while round and chuck prices are expected to be steady to lower.

Turkey Market Trends

- Little has changed in the turkey complex. MST spot supply is thin and higher prices for competing products have sellers confident in holding on to firm offers.
- Thigh meat market shows some improvement on limited supply and improving export intertest.
- Breast meat market continues to trade flat as foodservice demand so far has been underwhelming.
- Supply of whole turkeys in cold storage at the end of February was 2% higher than last year but still 19% lower than the five year average. Inventory build in February fell short of normal as freezing weather impacted production.
- The supply of turkey breast in cold storage at the end of February was 27% lower than a year ago. In the near term this is not having an impact as foodservice demand remains weak. However, as demand recovers, lower poult placements and lower freezer stocks could be inflationary.






PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS




CATTLE MARKETINGS, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS










CONTRIBUTION TO YEAR/YEAR CHANGE IN MEXICO BEEF PRODUCTION


