Pork Market Trends:

- Hog slaughter in the last four weeks has averaged 2.47 million head/week, 3% higher than in 2019 (comparisons to 2020 are not appropriate due to COVID). This is a bit higher than what USDA inventory survey suggested. However, since March, hog supply has been close to expectations. We should see hog slaughter decline by about 100k head/wk in May and June from current levels.
- Pork product markets remain firm although some items, like trim and bellies, pulled back somewhat. Given the outlook for lower production and the decline in hog weights, we think prices still have more upside risk in June and July.
- Pork freezer stocks remain 25% below the five year average, which also adds to the price risk for late spring and summer.
- Pork exports have been robust despite a USDA adjustment in export data reported last week.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Broiler producers are looking to ramp up production given the shortfall in supply so far and ever increasing foodservice demand. Egg sets for the latest reported week were 7% higher than the COVID skewed numbers a year ago but also 1.7% higher than in 2019.
- Spot supply for a number of products remains limited. Fast food promotions, especially the McDonalds Crispy Chicken promo and KFC chicken sandwich, have had a significant impact on supply availability. We think that high beef prices last year and fears of continued beef shortages this year caused fast food operators to pivot and feature more chicken sandwiches this spring.
- High feed costs remain a key concern and will likely continue to drive chicken price inflation through the summer. Corn prices are now at \$6.5/bushel, the highest since 2013. Weather will be a big factor this summer.

Beef Market Trends:

- Cattle and beef prices have been moving in opposite direction in the last two weeks. This is because beef demand remains very strong and packers are bumping against capacity constraints to fill orders. On the other hand, feedlot supplies remain plentiful and feedlots in some parts of the country have had to lower the price in order to get rail space.
- Wholesale beef prices are up across the board but prices for briskets and tenderloins are at record levels for this time of year, driven by strong foodservice demand.
- Beef retail demand is extremely strong as well as retailers look to feature more beef in order to hit revenue targets. Flap meat is very tight as distributors struggle to fill retail orders.
- China has emerged as a major market for US beef and US exports to this market in 2021 are expected to hit 120k MT.

Turkey Market Trends

- We do not expect to see a recovery in turkey supplies until Q4 but more likely first half of 2022. Poult placements in the first three months of the year were down 7% from a year ago and 10% lower than the five year average. This implies limited supply through late summer.
- Freezer inventories of whole birds were down 1.4% from last year and 15% lower than the five year average. Turkey breast inventory is down 26% from the five year average as processors continue to struggle with weak demand and are not willing to carry the same level of inventory.
- Higher prices for competing proteins, especially the sharp spike in the value of MSC and pork trim, has resulted in significantly higher prices for MST. Dark meat prices are quickly moving higher as well, with thigh meat price up 11% in the last four weeks alone and up 37% since start of the year.






Barrow/Gilt Dressed Carcass Weights, 5-day Moving Avg. - All hogs








Weekly Average FI Cattle Carcass Weights (Includes Fed & Non Fed Cattle)






All Beef In Cold Storage at End of Month








PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS




CATTLE MARKETINGS, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS

FEEDLOT TURN-OVER RATE (MARKETINGS VS. INVENTORY)










CONTRIBUTION TO YEAR/YEAR CHANGE IN MEXICO BEEF PRODUCTION
