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### **Pork Market Trends:**

- Packers continue to face a very tight hog market, with cash hog prices in some parts of the country as high as \$125/cwt. Negative margins will force some packers to reduce slaughter, especially once they have filled orders for Memorial Day.
- Slaughter last week dropped to 2.4 million head and we think it will be lower again in the next two weeks. The reduction should continue to bolster prices for processing items, with hams, bellies and pork trim more vulnerable to price inflation this summer.
- Corn prices are now at the highest price since 2012 and the increase will negatively impact hog production decisions for next spring.
- Belly prices retreated recently but expectations are for prices to climb above \$200/cwt in June and July. Mexico demand continues to underpin ham values.

### **Chicken Market Trends:**

- Broiler supply so far has not kept with the increase in demand. Most broiler items have significant price inflation and breasts, wings and MSC are the most sought after products.
- Wide promotions of chicken sandwiches this spring has been a factor but not the only factor. Rather, we think the winter storm in February significantly affected supply availability in the open market. Processors also continue to face labor challenges. The price of bone-in breasts is currently trading at a wide discount to boneless product, underscoring the labor availability bottlenecks.
- The price of MSC product continued to move higher last week as spot supplies are almost non-existent and spot buyers struggling to find product.
- Prices for leg quarters getting seasonal support from retail demand going into the grilling season.

### **Beef Market Trends:**

- Wholesale beef prices have been explosive as retailers and foodservice operators struggle to fill their needs. Lack of slaughter capacity in the beef sector has been further exacerbated by limited labor availability and rising rates of absenteeism.
- Strong export demand has also contributed to higher beef prices, with March exports at all time record levels. Based on weekly export data, we think April shipments were just as strong. China has now become the third largest market for US beef.
- Steak cuts have seen the most appreciation as food service demand has quickly rebounded. Rise in ground beef prices has been more muted, presenting retailers with feature opportunities in June.

#### **Turkey Market Trends**

- Turkey prices also advancing following the broader inflation for meat protein. Prices for whole birds have quickly escalated as end users look to bolster inventories. Last year tight inventories resulted in significant price inflation and users are looking to hedge some of that risk via larger freezer stocks.
- Breast meat prices also gained some traction in the last two weeks. Part of this is seasonal but also it reflects the impact of improving food service demand and higher prices for competing products, especially ham.
- Poult placements in Q1 were down 7% y/y and high feed costs will temper any production growth plans in the near term. This remains inflationary for prices in the second half of the year.
- Turkey exports to Mexico in March were 20% higher than a year ago and 71% of all turkey export shipments.
