Pork Market Trends:

L TRADING

- Hog slaughter was higher than expected this past week as robust pork prices and modestly lower hog values incentivized packers to run larger slaughter schedules on Friday and Saturday.

- July futures were sharply higher, however, as market thinks packers are pulling some of the supply forward. There will be a lot of interest when USDA publishes its June 'Hogs and Pigs' inventory regarding the size of the breeding herd and supply availability in the summer and fall.

- Last week the prices for bone-in hams declined and we believe it was associated to the slowdown in export orders. Sales to Mexico are now well below the pace of export shipments. Prices for fresh pork, on the other hand, continue to be supported by holiday retail demand, especially butts and ribs.

- Belly prices have found some stability. Going forward, foodservice demand remains key for this item.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Market was reportedly more balance this week, especially with regard to chicken breasts. Prices appeared to stabilize after several weeks of escalating prices. Large chains continue to run chicken sandwich promotions, which is bolstering breast meat demand in the near term.

- Demand for wings continues to outpace supply, however. Processors are rationing supply in order to service all accounts. Spot supply is extremely thin and prices continue to trend higher.

- Recent trend for egg sets is higher than the pandemic affected supply a year ago but close to 2019 levels. High feed costs and productivity bottlenecks are expected to limit supply growth in the near term.

- Chicken breast market has stabilized but spot supply remains limited given ongoing foodservice promotions. Thigh meat prices, especially boneless, are very firm.

Beef Market Trends:

- Wholesale beef prices continued to ratchet higher in the past two weeks as Memorial Day demand and restaurant industry reopening has created a significant bullwhip effect along the supply chain.

- Packers continue to be very hard sold on a number of key items, with prices for some steak cuts now at record levels. Spot supply is extremely tight and small buyers that usually rely on spot market are finding it very difficult to source product.

- Limited imported beef supply and seasonal improvement in demand has caused lean grinding beef prices to move higher. On the other hand, heavy carcass weight and lack of lean beef (for blending) has caused fat beef trim prices to collapse.

- Drought conditions and poor pastures are forcing some liquidation, implying higher beef prices longer term.

Turkey Market Trends

- Turkey supply availability will be limited in the near term but increase in April poult placements should help supply availability later in the fall. April poult placements were 22.244 million, up 7.7% from the previous month and slightly higher than the previous year.

- Fast food demand has shown significant improvement and reopening of the economy means a recovery in lunch time sandwich demand. Turkey breast prices have jumped from around \$160/cwt for much of the last 12 months to \$215/ cwt currently.

- MST prices remain extremely firm tight labor supply continues to limit supply coming to market.

- Whole bird market is well sold and prices hold a very firm undertone. Thigh meat prices steadily advancing and now up as much as 55% from two months ago and holding a premium to both 2020 and 2019.




PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS




INVENTORY OF CATTLE THAT HAVE BEEN ON FEED FOR 120 DAYS OR MORE

FEEDLOT TURN-OVER RATE (MARKETINGS VS. INVENTORY)



CONTRIBUTION TO YEAR/YEAR CHANGE IN MEXICO BEEF PRODUCTION




