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## **Pork Market Trends:**

- Pork production declined 17% from the previous week as a result of the holiday shortened week as well as the cyber attack on JBS.
- The decline in supply significantly impacted availability across the supply chain. Pork wholesale prices are now near the highest levels in a decade and lean hog futures closed at contract highs on Friday as spot supply remains limited.
- Ham prices have recovered following big product sales to Mexico in the last two weeks. Seasonally pork supplies decline in June and July due to lower slaughter and lighter carcass weights.
- Pork belly prices are trending higher yet again, in part because processors are getting ready for 4th of July business and higher retail features in July.

#### **Chicken Market Trends:**

- Market for chicken breasts and whole birds appeared to stabilize before the cyber attack on JBS created some spot shortages.
- High feed costs and low productivity will likely continue to drive cost inflation in the broiler sector in the near term. Spot corn prices are now are \$7 per bushel, more than double what they were last year. The layer hatching flock on May 1 was 4.8% higher than last year and yet producers are placing fewer chicks in grow out houses than a year ago.
- Market for wings appears to have hit a wall as retailers/ foodservice operators are finding it more difficult to pass on the higher costs to consumers. Tenders and b/s thigh meat remain in tight supply and pricing is very firm. Boneless/ skinless breast market is called steady, with some weakness in spots. Supply of MSC remains extremely limited.

#### **Beef Market Trends:**

- Beef market remains extremely tight and prices have increased for almost all products, especially for thin meats and round/chuck cuts.
- Production was down 75 million pounds (-14.5%) from the previous week due to Memorial Day on Monday and 1.5 day of lost production at JBS plants. It will be difficult for packers to make up the shortfall because they were already running at full capacity before this.
- Ground beef prices have increased 90% since mid March. Seasonal demand improvement into the grilling season as well as high prices for high quality beef cuts have caused retailers to ramp up ground beef features.
- High price of ground beef and need to feature less expensive beef cuts have caused prices for round and chuck prices to escalate, with round primal up 25% in May alone.

#### **Turkey Market Trends**

- Turkey breast prices have increased sharply in recent weeks as the recovery in fast food demand is starting to bump up against supply cuts that were put in place a few months ago. All along we warned about the potential for higher turkey prices due to ongoing industry contraction. Now those high prices are here, with turkey breasts up 36% since mid April and likely to escalate further.
- Prices for other turkey products have also escalated but not to the same degree. Thigh meat prices have increased about 20% in the last few weeks while MST and Breast trim prices have gained about 15%.
- Producers have responded to the demand recovery by increasing poult placements, which in April were about 1% higher than the previous year. This will do little to help supplies in the near term and higher prices are expected.




#### All Beef In Cold Storage at End of Month










#### **PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS**




#### **CATTLE MARKETINGS**, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS

#### FEEDLOT TURN-OVER RATE (MARKETINGS VS. INVENTORY)






