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Pork Market Trends:

- Hog slaughter should be near annual lows, with slaughter last week a little over 2.3 million head. Scheduled maintenance work, summer holidays and seasonal decline in hog supplies have all contributed to the decline. However, we think by late August weekly slaughter will gain about 100k head and by early October it will be 300k head higher than this week.
- Light slaughter continues to keep product markets tight. Processors are caught short, in part because they have smaller freezer stocks but also because demand from retail and foodservice remains strong. Prices for processing items, bellies, hams, trim, should be at annual highs.
- Packers recognize the supply increase that is coming and were more aggressive in selling to export last week, with sales to Mexico topping 25k MT. However, sales to Asian markets remain weak, which may weigh on prices in the fall.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Hatchability remains a major problem for broiler producers, limiting the number of birds coming to market despite a significant increase in the hatchery flock. The ratio of chicks hatched vs. eggs produced has been under 70% in the last four months of this year. At the start of the pandemic it was at 72% and 10 years ago it was at an all time high of 78%.
- Broiler slaughter and production should hold steady for the next few weeks and combined with the seasonal decline in demand, this is expected to keep prices in check. Seasonally we expect prices for breast meat to drift lower in the fall but still remain well above year ago levels.
- Supply of MSC, trim, tenders and boneless/skinless thigh meat remains extremely tight and prices are still holding very firm. Leg quarters, bone-in thigh meat and bone-in breasts are weaker, however. Tight labor supply remains a major challenge and continues to drive premiums for some items.

Beef Market Trends:

- Cattle slaughter last week was about the same as the previous week and 2.6% higher than in 2019. However, slaughter is up because of more cows coming to market as producers liquidate their herds. Fed cattle slaughter, which impacts the value of the choice cutout, is still running about 9k head or 1.7% lower than in 2019.
- Labor remains a major challenge for all packers and this is reflected in the value of highly trimmed products. The price of peeled outside skirts, for instance, jumped to over \$15 a pound last week, an almost \$3.50 premium to regular trim product.
- The choice beef cutout on Friday was 4% higher than just two weeks ago. More than half of the increase is due to higher prices for beef ribs. Prices for end cuts have started to trend higher, as well, led by inside rounds and flats.

Turkey Market Trends

- Turkey market was largely steady last week as supply of processing items appears to be in good balance. The market remains short on whole birds and expectations are for whole bird prices to continue to move higher in the next three months.
- Turkey supply will likely remain constrained through the end of the year as poult placements in Q2 were 3.3% lower than the already low levels of a year ago. Producers have sought to offset some of the reduction in chicks placed on feed by getting them to heavier weights. Turkey weights in 2021 are forecast up 5% from where they were in 2017. Heavy weight birds mean more breast meat but the supply of wings, drums and thigs will remain tight.
- MST prices continue to trade very firm given high prices for competing beef, pork and chicken items.






PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS




CATTLE MARKETINGS, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS

FEEDLOT TURN-OVER RATE (MARKETINGS VS. INVENTORY)










CONTRIBUTION TO YEAR/YEAR CHANGE IN MEXICO BEEF PRODUCTION


