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Pork Market Trends:

- Hog futures remain under pressure on uncertainty about outlook of processing items (hams, bellies, trim) this summer. Belly market appears to have more risk given slowdown in foodservice sales. Lack of frozen inventory continues to impact export markets, however.
- Ham prices have been volatile, largely reflecting export activity. Following three weeks of poor export sales to Mexico in May, ham values trended lower and under \$80/cwt. But it took one big sales week for spot market to get cleaned up and prices to push higher. Lower slaughter/production will help underpin ham values this summer, especially if export demand holds up.
- Loin availability remains limited on robust domestic sales. Some of this is seasonal as retailers focus on grilling items. Availability will remain limited through mid July but should see notable improvement by August.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Breast meat prices appear to be following long run seasonals better than they did last year. Prices were higher in April and May as retailers looked to feature more chicken for the start of the grilling season but now have started to trend lower.
- Chicken sales at foodservice are likely to face the same headwinds as other proteins. As consumers pull back, there will be more competition for sales volume but less traffic means lower sales volume overall. The concern, we think, is reflected in actions of chicken processors. Different from last year, when they sought to offset decline in productivity by increasing the size of the hatchery flock, they have kept the hatchery flock size in check and as of May 1 it was 3.5% lower than a year ago. This will continue to limit chicken supply in the second half of the year. Processors are intent on preventing a price collapse as seasonal demand declines.

Beef Market Trends:

- The inventory of cattle on feed is now lower than a year ago and ongoing reduction in placements will eventually result in even lower feedlot supplies. In the near term the supply of market ready remains above year ago levels. However, with fewer replacement cattle in the pipeline, feedlots will be incentivized to hold on to their cattle longer, adding more pounds in the feedlot. This explains why fed cattle prices remain firm despite higher front end supplies.
- Fed cattle weights are currently running 3.5% above last year, offsetting the reduction in slaughter. This has resulted in more fat beef trim. Lean beef prices, however, are record high as cow slaughter (a big part of the lean grinding beef supply) is down as much as 15% from a year ago. Consumer shift to less expensive beef items has also bolstered demand for ground beef. Lean cuts, such as rounds and chucks, have been supported as well given the high grinding value.

Turkey Market Trends

- Slaughter numbers have declined sharply in recent weeks, reflecting the lower pace of poult placements earlier this year. Lower placements for much of winter and spring as well as ongoing losses due to HPAI outbreaks, imply that slaughter will remain limited through the summer.
- The decline in slaughter has done little to support the breast meat market in the near term. High prices at retail and foodservice as well as broad based slowdown in foodservice sales have resulted in ample spot availability. The need to bring down freezer inventories has added further downward pressure on breast meat prices.
- Lower slaughter has limited the supply of drums, thighs and wings, items for which there is more stable domestic and export demand. As a result, prices for these items have been very firm and expected to trend higher during the summer months.




Barrow/Gilt Dressed Carcass Weights, 5-day Moving Avg. - Packer Hogs










WEEKLY STEER AND HEIFER SLAUGHTER. '000 HEAD




Weekly Average FI Cattle Carcass Weights (Includes Fed & Non Fed Cattle)










LAYERS ON 1ST OF MONTH: BROILER TYPE HATCHING. '000 Head







US WEEKLY BROILER EGG SETS






TURKEY THIGH, FRESH, USDA










PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS












CONTRIBUTION TO YEAR/YEAR CHANGE IN MEXICO BEEF PRODUCTION


Beef Carcass Prices
