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### Pork Market Trends:

- Futures have rallied the last two weeks as market participants now expect Q4 production to be less than previously thought. USDA 'Hogs and Pigs' survey suggested Sep-Nov slaughter could be up as much as 4% y/y. Instead slaughter since September 1 has been almost unchanged.
- Fresh pork prices continue to perform well, thanks in part to lower than expected slaughter but also robust retail features. Loin prices should start to ease lower into November as retailers shift their merchandising towards holiday items.
- Mexican buyers stepped in last week to book over 24k MT, double the volume of previous weeks. This may help bolster ham prices in late October and early November.
- Pork trim prices have been well supported to this point but should start to slowly trend lower in the last two months of the year. Belly prices continue to trade very firm.

#### **Chicken Market Trends:**

- Hurricane Helene created significant disruptions and industry has yet to come to grips with the full extent of the damage. Additionally, the dockworker strike may have been short but it also resulted in a lot of disruption, with exporters and other market participants moving loads around. This has made for a very confusing market and odd price movements. For instance, whole bird prices usually trend lower in October. Instead they went up as retailers struggled to find enough supply.
- Breast meat prices have been trending lower and this is expected to continue into November. Thigh meat prices have not declined, in part because of a short term shift in demand when breast meat was hard to find back in August. Eventually thigh meat prices are expected to follow breast meat values lower. Leg quarters are very firm as spot supply continues to fall well short of export needs.

#### **Beef Market Trends:**

- The situation in the beef market varies greatly depending on the product. Fed beef supply was expected to decline in the second half of the year. Instead, fed beef production in the last four weeks has been up as much as 5% vs. a year ago. This has helped keep prices for high value cuts, such as ribeyes and tenderloins under year ago levels.
- Retail demand for lean cuts, such as chucks, tends to be robust in October and that has been the case so far this year as well. Prices are tracking near last year even with more supply. Round prices have not performed as well, in part because high prices in July and August limited the ability of retailers to book product.
- The increase in production and especially heavy cattle weights (+3% y/y) have resulted in more 50CL trim and sharply lower prices.

#### **Turkey Market Trends:**

- It is quite telling that the price of fresh breast meat declined last week even as overall slaughter remains about 5% below year ago levels. The inventory of breast meat in cold storage at the end of August was 17% higher than a year ago despite the steady decline in production. Frozen breast meat has been trading as much as 30% below the price of fresh, another indication that demand continues to fall short of available supply.
- Whole turkey prices have been well below expected levels as well. High prices in the last two years and uncertainty about supply availability due to HPAI outbreaks have significantly damaged demand for this item. But not all turkey items have struggled. Demand for turkey thighs, and especially drums, far outpaces supply available. The result is upward trending prices, something that's expected to continue through at least the end of the year.


#### TURKEY MEAT - SCAPULA, FROZEN, USDA, WT.AVG.





## September 1 Inventory of All Hogs and Pigs. 1993 - 2024




