Pork Market Trends:

- Supplies of pork in the spot market remain burdensome due to the backup of product in Chinese ports and the need to divert product into domestic markets or other export channels.
- Ham values improved last week as participants sought to take advantage of the 30% price correction. Export shipments to Mexico remain strong and USDA data also showed robust shipments to other markets.
- Belly prices remain extremely weak, a result of big freezer stocks carried over from last year and other pork products going into the freezer. Seasonally belly prices do not improve until April.
- Faced with deteriorating margins packers sought to reduce slaughter last week. But this does little to resolve the current issues in the US market. Supplies will remain burdensome unless/until China demand picks up again.

Chicken Market Trends:

- Broiler producers have also been negatively impacted by the congestion in Chinese ports. Some reports indicate that up to 400 containers of chicken products, mostly chicken feet, have been diverted away from Chinese ports.
- The disruption to the export supply chain comes at a time when US broiler producers have ramped up production in hopes of better demand. Broiler slaughter since the start of the year has averaged about 5% higher than a year ago. Broiler weights are also trending above last year, resulting in supply growth that is far higher than the natural absorption capacity of the domestic market.
- Prices for most chicken products have been trending lower in recent weeks. Breast meat prices are near all time record lows and prices for some dark meat items are down as much as 15% from just a few weeks ago.

Beef Market Trends:

- Fed cattle futures have declined about 5% in the last few weeks, largely due to managed funds cutting back on their bullish bets.
- Most recent USDA projections put beef supplies in first half of the year up 4% over year ago. However, supplies are expected to be lower y/y in the second half.
- Cattle on feed supplies at the start of the year were up 2.3% and early estimates indicate that the on feed inventory on February 1 may be about 2.6% higher than last year. Winter this year has been relatively mild, contributing to carcass weights that are about 1% higher than a year ago.
- Ground beef features at retail in the last few weeks have averaged about 15% below year ago. This has put pressure on grinding beef, with fat trim now trading in the low 50s. Lean beef prices have also traded counter seasonally lower.

Turkey Market Trends

- Turkey slaughter is expected to be under year ago levels through the first half of 2020. Heavier weights will help offset some of the reduction in slaughter but USDA still expects output in Q1 to be down 0.8% and Q2 to be down 0.7%.
- Production should rebound for later in the year, in part to support Thanksgiving demand but also expected higher exports to both North American and Asian markets.
- Turkey exports in December were down 5% than a year ago despite higher exports to Mexico. Sharply lower exports to a number of Caribbean markets contributed to the y/y decline in December.
- Whole bird prices remain very firm on limited supply. Turkey breast prices, however, have been trending lower as availability is ample and lower prices for competing proteins have negatively impacted deli demand.
















Y/Y Ch. in Dec. 19 vs. Dec 18 US Fr, Froz & Pres Pork Export Volume










Y/Y Ch. in Dec. 19 vs. Dec 18 US Beef and Veal Export Volume












