Pork Market Trends:

- US pork market volatility has been explosive in the last two weeks. Hog slaughter in the last four weeks has averaged 7% above year ago levels and combined with higher weights pork production has been +8% higher.
- While pork supplies have been extremely high for this time of year, the pace of exports appears to have slowed down. Export sales to China have been lower than expected and high ham prices also appeared to negatively impact sales to Mexico. We have sharply adjusted some of our projections.
- The spread of the Novel Coronavirus in China is seen as a major threat for the US pork industry. In the short term the virus has caused significant disruptions to logistics and foodservice demand. Longer term the virus could do real economic damage to the Chinese and world economy, negatively impacting consumer disposable incomes and spending.

Chicken Market Trends:

- US broiler producers were buoyed at the end of 2019 as China removed restrictions on US exports. There was broad expectation this would result in a significant jump in exports to that market.
- The hatching flock on January 1 was estimated 2.7% higher than the previous year and at an all time record level. Seasonally the flock increases into spring so we should see supplies continue to increase, resulting in more eggs available for placement in incubators.
- Large freezer stocks and +4% increase in slaughter has resulted in burdensome supplies of boneless/skinless chicken breasts. Thigh meat prices have also come under some pressure recently but should improve into the spring on better domestic seasonal demand and higher exports.
- Wing prices will likely peak in the next few weeks and then be lower into spring/summer.

Beef Market Trends:

- The US cattle market appears to be somewhat more stable that the hog market but lower equity prices and the outlook for more supply in Q2 has pressured prices in the near term.
- The USDA 'Cattle Inventory' report noted that the calf crop in 2019 was down 0.7% from a year ago, a bigger decline that analysts were expecting.
- US cattle industry expansion has come to an end, evidenced by the 1% decline in the number of beef and dairy cows and 1.9% decline in the number of heifers retained for beef cow herd rebuilding.
- Based on current inventory levels, we think US slaughter will decline by around 1.2% in the second half of 2020 and it will decline by about 2% in 2021.
- In the short term lean beef cuts will continue to receive some retail support. Top butt prices are higher into spring.

Turkey Market Trends

- Turkey slaughter remains constrained but we continue to see heavier birds come to market.
- The market for whole birds appears to be well balanced at this time and this has helped keep prices steady. Seasonally we see prices start to climb from this point on and all indications are for whole bird prices to maintain a premium over 2019 levels.
- Breast meat prices are soft. Supplies are burdensome in the near term and uncertainty about prices of other proteins, especially hams, have added to the downward pressure.
- Thigh meat prices seem to be performing better, in part because export orders have invariably come into lend some support. On the other trim and MST prices hold a somewhat weaker undertone at this time. The market for drums is seen as steady at this time.
















Barrow/Gilt Dressed Carcass Weights, 5-day Moving Avg. - All hogs

Weekly Average FI Cattle Carcass Weights (Includes Fed & Non Fed Cattle)



















U.S. ALL CATTLE ON FEED: 1,000+ CAPACITY FEEDLOTS




PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS




CATTLE MARKETINGS, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS

FEEDLOT TURN-OVER RATE (MARKETINGS VS. INVENTORY)


