### Pork Market Trends:

- President Trump and Chinese officials are expected to sign the Phase 1 of a trade deal on January 15. This is expected to open the door to substantially more US pork exports to China. Some estimates are calling for US pork exports to China to almost triple compared to 2019 levels.
- US pork sales to Mexico were sharply higher at the end of the year, as buyers likely sought to take advantage of the seasonal post holiday decline in price. This could set the stage for higher ham prices in February and March.
- Pork belly prices remain extremely volatile. Reduced processing hours and record slaughter caused supplies to back up and pressured prices lower. Current low prices should stimulate demand in Q1 and expectations are for belly values to increase by 30 cents in the next few weeks.
- Picnic prices should be seasonally lower in January but strong export demand will keep prices well above 2019.

#### **Chicken Market Trends:**

- There is a lot of optimism in the US broiler industry these days about resurgent China demand. Some private analysts are currently projecting US sales of chicken and chicken paws to surpass 1 billion in 2020 compared to sales of just \$100 million this year.
- Robust profits during 2019 encouraged producers to try and expand. Broiler slaughter since August has averaged about 4% higher than a year ago and broiler production has increase by 5% during that period.
- Good export demand has helped keep leg quarter prices steady despite the increase in production. On the other hand, prices for b/s breast meat remain weak and cold storage data showed a significant increase in freezer inventories.
- Prices for broiler wings should peak in February and then start to move lower in April and May.

#### **Beef Market Trends:**

- As we speculated a few weeks ago, the sharp spike in the value of grinding beef and round/chuck cuts appears to have affected retailer feature plans. Latest USDA data shows beef sales for delivery 22-60 days out are down 15% y/y.
- Ground beef prices have struggled recently, in part because we think retailers are featuring more pork and chicken. Similarly, prices for beef round cuts and beef chuck cuts are currently as much as 15% lower than they were in November.
- The price of 50CL beef trim has been far lower than expected due to weak ground beef demand and more cuts (which are fattier) going into the grinder.
- Imported beef prices have posted a sharp correction as Chinese buyers have stepped to the sidelines and in some cases have sought to renegotiate contracts.

#### **Turkey Market Trends**

- Supply cuts have started to pay off for producers but we do not expect a quick turnaround in the industry despite recent margin improvement.
- Whole bird prices were very firm during the holidays and reports show significantly lower carryover stocks post Christmas. Whole bird prices are starting the year at a much higher price levels than in previous years.
- Producers placed 8% fewer poults in November and placements were lower for all of 2019. Current placement numbers suggest lower slaughter through the first half of 2020. We think this will continue to support prices for whole birds, dark meat and trim.
- Breast meat prices are expected to be steady in the near term but should move higher in Q2 on account of limited supply growth and higher prices for competing product, especially hams.


















### December 1 Inventory of All Hogs and Pigs. 1993 - 2019

# December 1 Inventory of Hogs Kept for Breeding. 1993 - 2019. Source: USDA-NASS








