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#### Pork Market Trends:

- Pork supplies remain plentiful in the near term. Lack of freezer capacity has created bottlenecks and depressed prices for some items, especially bellies.

- Belly freezer stocks are currently as much as 57% higher than the five year average. Retail bacon prices remain high as retailers see little reason to run promotions during this time of year. However, tighter supplies in Q2 and seasonal demand improvement should bolster belly prices.

- Retail demand for loins tends to improve in March and prices have gained ground. Ham prices also gained ground last week and remain significantly above year ago on strong export demand.

- Spread of Coronavirus is seen as generally bearish for protein but we think it tends to be less negative for pork (a retail item) than beef (a foodservice item).

- Large freezer stocks are generally bearish in near term.

#### **Chicken Market Trends:**

- Broiler supplies remain burdensome. Production has increased rapidly in recent months as producers look to ship more product to Asian markets. However, some of those plans have been upended by the spread of Coronavirus there and the bottlenecks in supply chains.

- China broiler prices are sharply lower, in part due to weaker foodservice demand but also due to the increase in domestic production and outbreaks of Avian Influenza. Weaker demand and higher supplies continue to weigh on China prices.

- Some US chicken product destined for the Chinese market has been diverted to other ports given long delays in unloading. Supply flows are slowly getting back to normal but spot market for breast meat and trim remains heavy.

- Total chicken supply in cold storage at the end of January was 12% higher than last year and +18% vs. 5-Yr avg.

#### Beef Market Trends:

- Cattle futures are down as much as 15% from just a few weeks ago. Speculative funds were bullish about beef demand in 2020 given record equity indexes, the Phase 1 agreement with China and slow supply growth. The outbreak of Coronavirus has upended many of those assumptions.

- We have revised lower our beef price forecasts, reflecting the heightened risk of weaker demand this spring and summer and the potential for lower beef exports and higher beef imports.

- The strong US dollar is also bearish for beef/cattle prices, making US products more expensive in the world market. S. Korea and Japan are two key buyers of US beef and a slowdown in foodservice business there will negatively impact US prices.

#### **Turkey Market Trends**

- Turkey slaughter in January was 1% lower than a year ago but producers were able to get birds to heavier weights. As a result, broiler production for the month was up 0.6% from a year ago.

- We think slaughter will be lower again in February, reflecting the steady reduction in poult placements last fall. Producers have been slowly increasing the number of poults placed on feed, with January placements up 2.6% from a year ago. This is the biggest y/y increase in poult placements since October 2017.

Whole bird prices remain firm on limited supplies and a smaller freezer inventory. At the end of January the supply of whole birds in the freezer was 35% lower than a year ago.
Breast meat prices remain weak, however, on strong competition from other proteins. Getting birds to higher weights also tends to bolster breast meat supplies.

Weekly Average FI Cattle Carcass Weights (Includes Fed & Non Fed Cattle)








#### BONELESS-SKINLESS TURKEY BREAST, TOM, FRESH, USDA





All Chicken In Cold Storage at End of Month










PLACEMENTS OF CATTLE ON FEED, +1000 CAPACITY FEEDLOTS








